### Research Background (300 words)



Start by stating the problem.



Why is the problem significant? (tangible implications, from social, environmental or economic perspectives).

Pro tip: Check this blog



Use available information to describe the magnitude of the problem. Number of farmers, % of GDP, health and environmental statistics.

# Research Aim (200 words)



Explicitly state the aim and ojectives.



Simplify a single aim and provide details in the objectives.

Pro tip: Check this blog



This section should flow into the research questions.

# Research Questions (200 words)

Y

Avoid questions that can be answered by "yes" or "no".

Pro tip: Check this blog



Make sure the questions are focused and specific (think about including details such as location, population or intervention).



Match the questions to the objectives.



Use the right verbs for the right type of questions.

What are the characteristics of ATP synthase?

How does human growth hormone mimic the action of testosterone?

What is the relationship between baldness and age?

Is it possible that VEGF has an effect in plant photosynthesis?

What is the cause of increased violence among young adults?

What is the efficacy of using toothpaste to heal mosquito bites?

RQ1 : Does having a dog at home require responsibility from a child?

RQ2 : In what ways does having a dog at home require responsibility from a child?

RQ1: How does aspirin affect older adult populations who suffer from low heart pressure?

RQ2: How do medication affect people?

Demonstrate your knowledge of the field.



Refine your methodology and research questions.

Do not forget references!




Identify the gaps in the literature.



Present any key concepts/frameworks.

### Methodology (300 words)

Describe your research approach (qualitative, quantitative, mixed).



Determine your methods and data collection tools.

Contribution to knowlegde and/or practice.



Think broadly about benefits of your work and who and how would you like to incluence.


### Key points about formulating the research proposal

- Missalignment between aims, questions, methods and outcomes.
