## Teachers encouraged to inspire future leaders - Prof Nabobo-Baba

These were the comments of Fiji National University's (FNU) Professor in Education, Professor Unaisi Nabobo-Baba during the joint World Teachers Day and Fiji Day Celebrations held at Natabua Campus, Lautoka yesterday.

Speaking to staff and students, most of whom are trainee teachers, the senior academic said teachers have the opportunity to empower and mould future leaders.

"Teachers play an integral role in inspiring students and those teachers who can inspire students will be long remembered," said Prof Nabobo-Baba.

"As teachers, you can inspire students who can accomplish amazing things. You have this important gift, so I urge you to use it to inspire our future leaders," she said.
